

# wrist cuff

Sew sparkling charms to a simple knitted strip to create a decorative wrist cuff.



## MATERIALS

- Approximately 20g of double knitting yarn
- Pair of 3.75mm knitting needles
- Medium-sized crochet hook for tied cuff
- Yarn needle
- Selection of charms
- Sewing needle and thread

## CIRCULAR CUFF SIZE

4.5 x 20cm.

## ABBREVIATIONS

See reading a pattern card.

## TO MAKE

Using 3.75mm needles cast on 11 sts.

M st row: K1, \*p1, k1, rep from \* to end.

This row forms the patt.

Cont in patt for 20cm. Cast off.

## FINISHING

Join cast-on and cast-off edges to form a ring. Sew a selection of charms at centre.

## TIED CUFF SIZE

3.5 x 17cm.

## ABBREVIATIONS

See reading a pattern card.

## TO MAKE

Using 3.75mm needles cast on 9 sts.

Work in g st (every row k) for 17cm.

Cast off.

## FINISHING

Using the crochet hook and 2 strands of yarn together, join yarn to centre of cast-on edge and work 20 ch. Fasten off.

Work a tie at centre of cast-off edge in the same way.

Sew in the ends. Tie a knot at the end of each tie.

Sew three charms at centre.
